## Prior Authorization Restored for DME and Home Infusion Supplies Effective December 1, 2022

Beginning December 1, 2022, Molina Healthcare of Michigan will reinstate pre-pandemic authorization requirements, as applicable, for select DME and home infusion supplies in accordance with MDHHS Policy MMP 22-40. This includes such items as documentation requirements (e.g., certificates of medical necessity [CMNs], documentation timelines, lab tests, etc.), walking boots, wheelchair batteries, blood pressure monitors, enteral formula/supplies, parenteral formula/supplies, home infusion/supplies, incontinence products, catheters, ostomy products, DMEPOS items. The policy also notes that coverage of hand sanitizers will end December 1, 2022.
