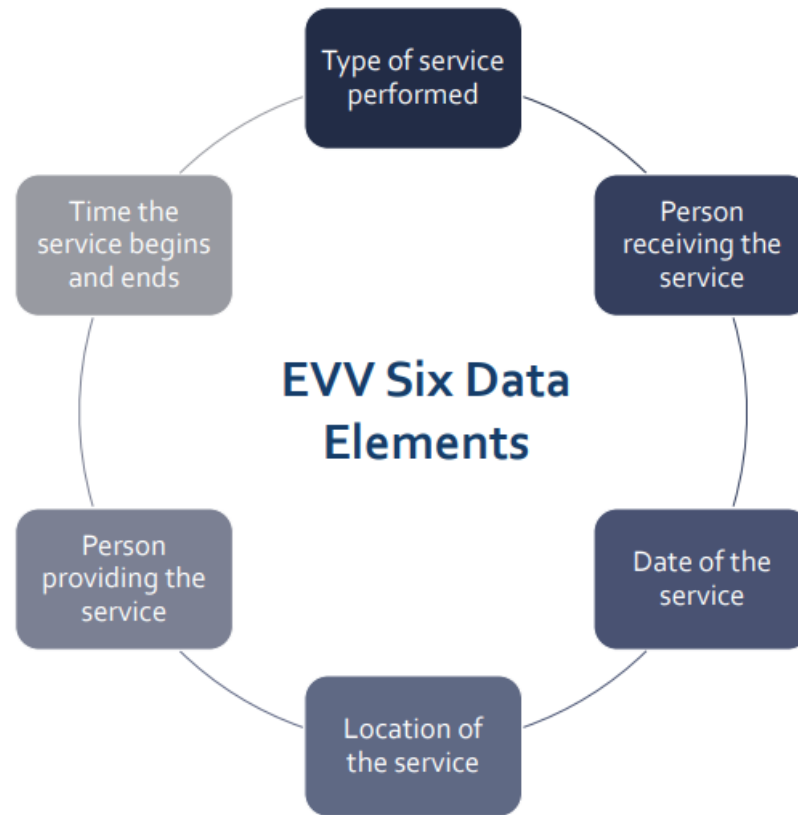

EVV Introduction

- Why EVV?
 - The 21st Century Cures Act passed by congress in December 2016 requires that providers of Personal Care Services confirm visits via Electronic Visit Verification.
- What is EVV?
 - Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) is a validation of the date, time, location, type of Personal Care or Home Health Care Services provided, and the individual(s) providing and receiving services. This information helps to ensure that beneficiaries, clients, or participants receive the expected care.
- What EVV system is being used?
 - MDHSS EVV System at no cost supported by [HHAeXchange](#) website.
 - Alternative approved system can be used at the agency's cost.

- Required six data elements

 - In order to complete this onboarding form, you will need the following information regarding your agency:
 - Company name, address, and phone number
 - Executive Director in your office (name, email, phone)
 - Agency Medicaid ID
 - Federal Tax ID
 - National Provider Identification (NPI)
 - Approximate number of customers your agency services today
 - Number of caregivers in your agency
 - List of Waivers your program works with/ primary contacts for each waiver at your agency

EVV PCS Service Codes

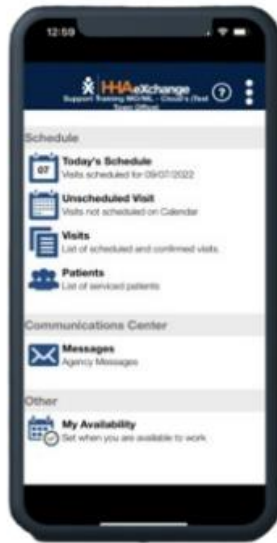
- Below procedure codes are required to use EVV:

Program	Procedure Code	Service Description
Behavioral Health	H2015	Community Living Supports (CLS)
	T1005	Respite Care, per 15 minutes
Home Help	N/A	Personal Care Services
MI Choice	H2015	Comprehensive Community Support Services, per 15 minutes
	S5150	Unskilled Respite Care, not Hospice, per 15 minutes
MI Health Link	H2015	Comprehensive Community Support Services, per 15 minutes
	S5150	Unskilled Respite Care, not Hospice, per 15 minutes
	T1019	Personal Care Services (PCS), per 15 minutes

NOTE: PCS provided through Community Transition Services are excluded from EVV at this time.

EVV Reporting

- Caregivers have two (2) options for recording and reporting EVV:



Caregiver Mobile App – allows caregivers to clock in/out using a mobile device with GPS capabilities.



Telephony/IVR – allows caregivers to clock in/out by calling a unique toll-free number using the beneficiary's landline phone.

EVV Exclusion

- Live-in caregivers
 - As outlined in MMP 24-41, Live-in caregivers are exempt from EVV requirements.
 - The caregiver lives in the same home as the beneficiary;
 - The home is the caregiver’s permanent and primary residence; and
 - The caregiver is responsible for providing PCS that require EVV to the beneficiary.
 - The Live-In Caregiver Attestation (BPHASA-2421) form should be completed and sent to the Adult Services Worker to indicate that the caregiver and beneficiary reside at the same address.
