

# STIMULANT USE DISORDER ECHO

The goal of Project ECHO is to increase health care capacity by democratizing knowledge and to strengthen the capacity among primary care providers. This program aims to support healthcare and mental health providers, staff, and administrators with Stimulant Use Disorder patient care.
